
NOTICE TO PARENTS
Right to Review Teacher Qualifications

To: ALL PARENTS
From: Wyoming County Schools Title I Department
Date: 2017-2018 School Year

As a parent of a student in the Wyoming County School System, you have the right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teacher(s) who instruct your child. Federal law allows you to ask for certain information about your child's classroom teacher(s) and requires us to give you this information in a timely manner if you ask for it. Specifically, you have the right to ask for the following information about each of your child's classroom teachers:

- Whether the West Virginia State Department of Education has licensed or qualified the teacher for the grades and subjects he or she teaches.
- Whether the West Virginia State Department of Education has decided that the teacher can teach in a classroom without being licensed or qualified under state regulations because of special circumstances.
- The teacher's college major; whether the teacher has any advanced degrees and, if so, the subject of the degrees.
- Whether any teachers' aides or similar paraprofessionals provide services to your child and, if they do, their qualifications.
