#### Industrial Equipment Maintenance

In a progressive and rapidly changing world of industry and technology, there is a great demand for knowledgeable, multi-skilled maintenance technicians. Employers seek professional technicians who can install, maintain and repair sophisticated equipment and systems, as well as envision and create more efficient and reliable systems. The Industrial Equipment Maintenance Program is designed to prepare students for careers in industry as technicians, engineers and managers. This program prepares students planning a career as an electrical/hydraulics systems maintenance technician, and students planning to pursue a two or four year degree in areas of electrical, mechanical or industrial engineering.

#### **Certified Internet Webmaster**

The Certified Internet Webmaster (CIW) foundation series of courses prepares student to their CIW Foundation certification. This certification is recognized throughout the industry as validating essential Internet skills for the workplace and proved the individual has evolved from being an Internet consumer to an Internet producer, capable of producing real-world Internet applications. Once certified, these students are ready to pursue specialties Web design, ecommerce, JavaScript, databases and other related fields.

#### **Plumbing**

This program of study introduces students to the knowledge base and technical skills related to Basic Plumbing. Areas of study include how water moves throughout a plumbing system, introduction to old, current and future technologies, and various material used in new construction and repair of older systems and the use of plumbing codes. Students successfully completing the Plumbing Program will be able to enter the workforce in a variety of career choices. Areas if employment include residential plumbing for new construction, repair of old systems, and becoming an independent contractor. Students will also be certified to work in light commercial buildings and as well as heavy industrial construction such as Pipefitters and Steamfitters. This program certifies under the NCCER curriculum which is recognized nationally.

#### Welding

Welding is used in all forms of industry and at all levels. Skilled welders vary from the entry level fabricator to the experts welding pipe in nuclear plants. Students enrolled in this course of study use up-to-date, industry standard welding processes and live work experiences to develop individual and work readiness skills. Those successfully completing the Welding Program exit with skills and knowledge necessary to enter the work force. Students interested in continuing their education have the opportunity to earn up to 28 college hours toward a 2 or 4 year degree. There are also opportunities to earn advanced placement into post-secondary technical schools. Welding uses NCCER curriculum and the certifications are recognized nationally.

## Presidential Awards for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching (PAEMST)

The Presidential Awards for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching (PAEMST) program recognizes the importance of honoring excellent teaching and promoting STEM education. PAEMST, a White House program administered by the National Science Foundation (NSF), is the nation's highest honor for K-12 teachers of mathematics and science (including computer science). Awardees receive a trip to D.C., a certificate signed by the President, and a \$10,000 award from NSF. To be eligible in 2017, teachers must be full-time employees of a school or school district who teach at the 7-12<sup>th</sup> grade level at least fifty

percent of the day, and have at least 5 years of teaching experience prior to this school year. Please consider nominating, and encouraging principals and teachers to nominate, 7-12<sup>th</sup> grade mathematics and science (including computer science) teachers at <a href="https://www.paemst.org">www.paemst.org</a> today. The nomination deadline is April 1, 2017.

### 2017 Science in the Arts Challenge

Science and art are everywhere, and the interdependence of the subjects is undeniable. Science in the Arts Challenge The encourages high school students to consider, research, and present information about relationships between the two seemingly different subjects. This year's Science in the Arts Challenge will be at the Charleston Civic Center in conjunction with the West Virginia Social Studies Fair on Friday, April 21, 2017. High school students may submit an entry for a visual arts product which they have created to represent Science in the Arts. Students must create a two- to three-minute video presentation that shows a timeline or tell the story of the artwork being created. In the video, the student should explain why the piece was selected to represent Science in the Arts, what the piece means to the student personally, and how science was used to create the art or the materials used to create the artwork; see the 2017 Science in the Arts Challenge Rules and 2017 Science in the Arts Challenge Rubric. The video must include the student creating the visual artwork and the student explaining the science process used to create artwork and/or demonstrating understanding the science of the materials used to create the artwork.


