The **2018 National Youth Science Camp** is a residential Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) honors program for 12th grade (high school seniors) STEM high achievers (June 27 - July 8, 2018, almost a month). Students from across the country (two are selected to represent each state and Washington, D.C.) are challenged academically in exciting lectures and hands-on studies, and have opportunities to participate in a comprehensive outdoor adventure program, gain a new and deep appreciation for the great outdoors, and establish amazing friendships. Applications open November 1, 2017 and close February 28, 2018.
